The Constables and Douzaine of St Sampson hereby give notice to the Ratepayers and Electors thereof that pursuant to the provisions of The Emergency Powers (Coronavirus) (Parochial Matters and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Guernsey) Regulations 2020 they will meet remotely at 7:30 pm on Monday, 11 May, 2020 and propose to agree to apply to the Royal Court for permission to levy the following amounts under Article 1 of the 1923 Law ("parochial tax") and the parish waste under the Parochial Collection of Waste (Guernsey Ordinance) 2018 ("parish waste").

The Constables and Douzaine shall consider any such representations and their consultations with the Rector and Churchwardens in ecclesiastical matters, in reaching any decisions at the said meeting.

All decisions reached on the question of applying for a Remede will be made available at www.stsampson.gg

A parish meeting to discuss and agree other matters will be called at a time in the future when the legislation referred to above is no longer applicable.

- (1) To Approve the Parochial Cemetery Accounts for 2019, which have been duly prepared and are available for inspection up to the Parish Meeting.
- (2) To pass the Constables' accounts for 2019, which have been duly May audited and can be viewed at www.stsampson.gg or inspected at the Constables' Office up to 8 May 2020.
- (3) To elect Auditors for the above accounts for 2020.
- (4) To decide whether they are in favour of voting the following amounts to be levied by means of **Owner's Rate** for the current year:

- (8) To authorise the Constables to apply to the Royal Court for a Remede to levy the agreed expenditure. To take all such measures relating to the above as the Ratepayers and Electors may deem advisable.
